## FOR DIVERS AND SNORKELERS

Most divers know Bonaire as one of the best sites in the Caribbean for excellent shore diving. The island is surrounded by a coral reef that has been officially protected as a marine sanctuary since 1975. But since 1961, government officials of this Dutch island have been taking legal steps to protect the natural environment. Coupled with the island's arid climate, this protection makes the waters that surround Bonaire clear and calm with up to 150 feet of visibility.

Denver Divers has reserved accommodations just in front of Bari Reef, ranked for the past 15 years as the number one site in the world for rich diversity of fish species. The reef is shallow and ideal for snorkeling as well as both day and night dives. Because of the calm conditions, this trip is perfect for families with divers and snorkelers of all ages and abilities.

Bonaire also offers spectacular diving without strong currents and temperature variations in the water – and without the need to dive deep to see plenty of marine life.

## FOR WINDSURFERS

Perhaps the best kept secret on Bonaire is Lac Bay – a Mecca for windsurfers throughout the world. The island's combination of wind, water, and land has created an ideal windsurfing environment. Winds across the bay's eight square kilometers are as reliable as sunshine in Bonaire, and its unique shape creates three distinct zones, each perfectly suited to particular skill levels.



Denver Divers' trip is during "high-wind season" at Lac Bay. That means conditions will be ideal for everyone from beginners to serious, high-intensity surfers looking for challenging conditions.
